


YTEXAS LEADERSHIP ACADEMY - 2024 PROGRAM

WHAT IS THE YTEXAS LEADERSHIP ACADEMY?

The **YTexas Leadership Academy** (TXLA) is a **501c (3) non-profit** program for Texas high school and college students to collaborate with business leaders for mentorship opportunities, relationship building, and advancing career pathways.

The academy fosters interaction with CEOs in the following industry sectors: Technology, Manufacturing, Healthcare, Sports/ Entertainment, Transportation/Aviation, Retail/Consumer Goods, Non-profit and Government, Energy, Business/Financial Services and Real Estate Services

Our signature event, the **YTexas Summit**, invites up to 500 students to **AT&T Stadium** to interact with executives, learn about career pathways, and sign an **NFL-style** pledge to pursue a career pathway while in school. At this event, students obtain yearlong access to the YTXLA app to gain tips from executives, track active internships, and apply directly to a college or trade school.




2 THE SUMMIT - 500 TEXAS STUDENTS

TEXAS STUDENTS

On Tuesday, October 1, employers, educators and students (from over 50 Texas schools) will meet at AT&T Stadium.

Students will meet on-the-field and in the Cowboys Clubs for a full-day of networking and leadership development.

- The field will be comprised of 24 networking hubs, where companies, cities and colleges showcase their products and programs driving the Texas economy.
- Students will navigate the field to learn about business use-cases for various technologies and envision a career pathway in a field of interest.
- Students use the YTXLA app to navigate the event, view internships and plan meetings with schools and companies. Students will receive a tour of the **Cowboys locker room**.


Each player entering the tournament donates \$1k to sponsor students for the YTXLA program.
