
YTexas is hosting our 2025 Summit: **The Official Texas Innovation Showcase** from Sept 23-25 in Houston, Texas.







THE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT & INNOVATION



The YTexas Summit will host (6) industry panel discussions, each consisting of 3 employers and a community college moderator. Each panel will be in a structured 30 minute discussion with industry C-level executives and educators, ensuring schools are aligning curriculum with market needs. The audience will include HR managers, industry leaders, school administrators, economic development professionals, and high school career counselors. All panels will be video recorded and executive produced.

Key Elements of the Discussion:

1. Employer Perspective:

- O Skill Requirements: Employers outline the technical and soft skills needed in their industry.
- o Industry Trends: They discuss emerging technologies, job roles, or certifications that schools should prioritize.
- O Hiring: Employers highlight gaps in candidates' qualifications, such as lack of practical experience or specific technical expertise.
- Collaboration Opportunities: Employers share current partnerships such as internships, apprenticeships, or on-the-job training

2. School Perspective:

- Curriculum Design: Schools explain current programs to meet industry needs, including practical training or updating courses.
- O Student Preparation: They discuss career counseling, work-based learning, or extracurricular activities that build employability.
- O Constraints: Schools address challenges like limited funding, outdated equipment, or keeping pace with rapidly changing industries.
- Feedback Needs: They seek employer input to refine curricula or create pathways for certifications.

3. Workforce Development Strategies:

- o Partnerships: Both parties explore collaborations, such as co-designed courses, job shadowing, or employer-sponsored projects.
- o Experiential Learning: Emphasis on internships, co-ops, or simulations to give students hands-on experience.
- O Skill Alignment: Aligning academic outcomes with in-demand skills, such as coding for tech jobs or customer service for retail.
- O Career Pathways: Creating clear routes from education to employment, including vocational training or degree career programs

4. Content strategy:

- Panel discussions will be video recorded and curated through a social media awareness campaign shared with schools, students, veterans, economic development organizations, non-profit organizations, and social media influencers.
- A report For CEOs by CEOs will be submitted within 90 days of the event to distribute to event attendees and YTexas subscribers..

Goals:

- For Employers: Access to a pipeline of qualified candidates and input into training programs.
- For Schools: Enhanced relevance of programs and better student outcomes.
- For Students: Clearer pathways to careers and exposure to real-world expectations.
